

Maths



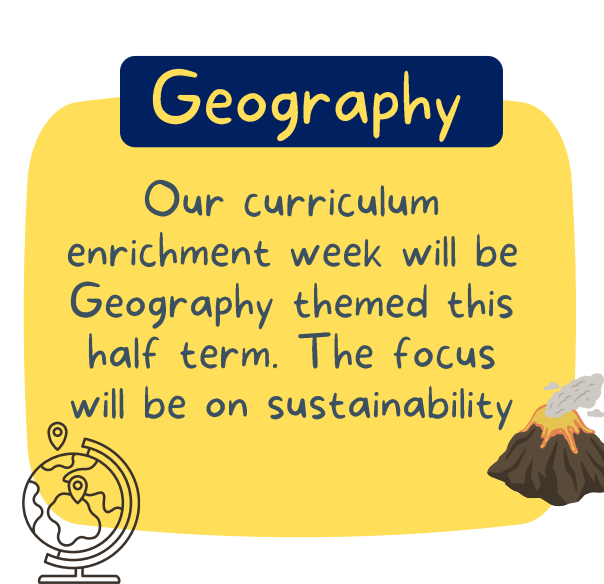
Children will practice and use their number bonds to 10 to support them in efficiently solving addition and subtraction problems. They will explore many different methods to support them in understanding the concepts deeply. They will then move onto a geometry unit where they will explore 2D and 3D shapes, learning their names and some of their properties.

English



Children will continue to practice forming full sentences, beginning them with a capital letter and finishing with a full stop. They will think about adjectives to describe nouns. Children will write postcards about the King's Coronation and Christmas Poetry. Read Write Inc will continue to be used to teach reading and spelling.

Geography



Our curriculum enrichment week will be Geography themed this half term. The focus will be on sustainability

Science



Children will be focusing on some chemistry learning this half term, studying a unit about materials. They will explore and classify materials based on their properties and will use this knowledge to choose materials for a given task/object. The children will know the difference between transparent and opaque materials.

History



Children will learn all about British monarchy including significant, recent monarchs as well as those from further in the past. They will explore family trees and succession. Children will understand how and when King Charles III came to the throne and what his role is as our King.

PE



Children will learn more fundamental movement skills with a Christmas theme. In their sessions outdoors, they will learn skills for playing a variety of team games. The class will be taking part in a KSI aesthetics festival at Dawlish College.

Creative Arts



Children will learn about creating structures in the Design and Technology lessons. They will study existing crowns before designing and creating their own. The half term will end with their Christmas performance, alongside Year 2.

RWE



Why does Christmas matter to Christians?: Children will build on their own personal knowledge and will find out about how Christmas is celebrated today considering which traditions are secular and which are religious.

PSHE



Celebrating Difference: Children will learn about similarities and differences between people and celebrate these. They will understand what bullying is and how to recognize when someone else needs help.

Computing



Creative Computing: This unit gives children the opportunity to develop their mouse, keyboard and basic computing skills using creative tools. Children will use the 2DIY tools to paint, create jigsaws and make simple drag and drop games.
