


Children will continue to develop the skills needed to play a range of team games. They will also learn new gymnastics skills



Route Explorers: This unit allows children to code using the tool, 2Go.









Children learn to build simple algorithms to move a screen turtle along routes. They consider direction and distances and create commands.













Children will be inspired by the work of Paul Klee to practice the techniques he used to create their own collages of
