

Maths

Children continue to practice using efficient methods for addition and subtraction of larger numbers (up to 4-digits). They will then complete a measurement unit all about area. After this, they will focus on multiplication and division methods. Mastering Number will be used each day to support the dep knowledge of all of the times tables.

History

Children will explore what life was like in the Ancient Egyptian times and know about significant individuals from the time. They will learn about Ancient Egyptian beliefs and the festivals that they celebrated. Children will also explore how archaeologists know so much about this time period.

Creative Arts

Children will develop their painting techniques whilst producing pieces inspired by Egyptian landscapes and people. They will rehearse for and perform in our Christmas Carol Concert.

English

Children will continue to develop their writing skills whilst writing Ancient Egyptian inspired myths and then creating Christmas themed poetry. They will continue to practice using correct punctuation and sentence structures to guide their reader. Reading will continue to be taught through whole class reading lessons and assessed through quizzing on Accelerated Reader.

Geography

Our curriculum enrichment week will be Geography themed this half term. The focus will be on sustainability

Science

Children will study a physics unit about sound. They will explore how sounds are made and will investigate how to change the volume and pitch of sounds. Children will also learn about the structure of the ear and how this helps us to hear sounds.

PE

Children will develop their gymnastics skills whilst being inspired by the shapes of the Ancient Egyptian landscapes. They will develop their team games skills whilst focusing on Tag Rugby.

MFL: French

Children will learn to name the seasons and have short discussions about these.

Computing

Children will complete a crash course in Coding supporting them to use the many programmes on Purple Mash to create and debug code. They will become familiar with algorithms and variables to create interactive scenes.

PSHE

Children will learn about how making assumptions about a person because of the way they look or act can influence how they are judged and that these impressions can be changed. They will think about harder to identify forms of bullying and understand why witnesses sometimes choose to join in.
